THE SCIENCE OF CLIMATE CONTROL

Why Climate Matters

Cigars are hygroscopic. This means they naturally exchange moisture with their environment. A cigar wants to be at 62-65% relative humidity and 68-70°F. Outside these parameters, chemistry shifts. Humidity: The Critical Variable

Temperature Stability

Temperature fluctuations stress tobacco. A humidor that maintains steady 65-70°F prevents the expansion and contraction that damages leaf integrity.

Active vs. Passive Climate Control

Passive Systems rely on absorbent materials (cedar, sponges, gels) to naturally maintain humidity. They're affordable but require monitoring and manual adjustments.

Active Systems use electronic sensors and automated humidification/dehumidification. They maintain precision without intervention. Premium humidors use active systems.
